Alexander "Al" Gregory, age 90 of Carneys Point and formerly of Salem died Friday October 31, 2008 at Merion Gardens in Carneys Point. Born in St. Louis, MO, he returned with his family to their native Albania where he was raised. He returned to the United States at the age of 17 and moved to Salem in 1952. He served in the US Army during WWII. Mr. Gregory was a member of the Albanian Orthodox Church of St. John Chrysostom, Philadelphia. A well known local restaurateur, he owned Al's restaurant in Salem (formerly the Terminal Restaurant) and know by many as "the Rec". Mr. Gregory loved his pets. He was predeceased by his wife, Elizabeth in 2007, a son, Michael in 1979, a sister, Eleanor Kosta and a brother, Piro Joti. He is survived by his daughter, Debra J. Shattuck and her husband, Dave of Salem and granddaughters, Kristie Smith Koerbel and her husband, Mike and Kaitlyn Coffey.
