Brian McNevin, of Penns Grove, left us on August 5, 2021, after a long struggle with diabetes.

He was predeceased by his parents Jean and Tom McNevin Sr, and is survived by his brother Tom McNevin, his wife Anne, and niece and nephews Daniel, Robert, Laura, and Russell. A 1977 graduate of Penns Grove High School, he was employed by VWR International in Bridgeport for the past 27 years. His main identity however was as a musician. While an extraordinary lead guitar player, he also played excellent bass in local band Tundra, doing original progressive rock, with a tri-state following in the 1980s, who will surely be missed by surviving members, Joe Pinnazotta and Joe Puzzutello.

Brian had been in discussion with Tom Petty about doing some recording with him after visiting him in Nashville before the latter's death in 2017.

He was also active politically, running for mayor of Penns Grove in 2015 and winning 37% of the vote.

Brian was cremated on August 7. There will be a graveside service on Thursday September 9 at 11:00 am at St. Joseph's Cemetery in Woodstown.
