Dan Anthony Del Signore Sr, 68, of Selbyville, DE, formerly of Carneys Point NJ, passed away peacefully on June 21, 2025. Dan was a carpenter/contractor by trade. He was a lifelong musician, best known for his talents on the guitar. Above all, Dan is most remembered as owner/operator of Del Hobbies Paintball, in Pedricktown, NJ, which was open for the better part of the 2000's. Preparing for the beach, always included packing our coolers, with lots of food and drinks, and stopping along the way, once my dad or Uncle Delio, found picnic tables, to eat, and drink and just enjoy being together. While the others were still eating, Danny and I were probably the first to get up from the table, and veer off , just to talk and laugh and just be ourselves. They had a few jam sessions together and of course, I would be right there, just amazed at Danny's guitar playing. The band was stunned, too, his synchronization of guitar playing and sound, was like no other. Danny, I will miss you.
