



Dorothy H. Ashcraft

September 16, 1921 - January 6, 2015

Dorothy H. Ashcraft (nee Herrman) age 93 of Penns Grove and formerly of Wilmington passed away on Tuesday January 6, 2015 at Willow Valley, Lancaster, PA where she had made her home for the past 10 years.

Born in Carneys Point, she was the daughter of the late Robert Lee and Dorothy W. (nee Coleman) Herrman.

Mrs. Ashcraft had been a member of St. Paul's United Methodist Church, Penns Grove for over 50 years. She had also been a member of the Penns Grove – Carneys Point Woman's Club.

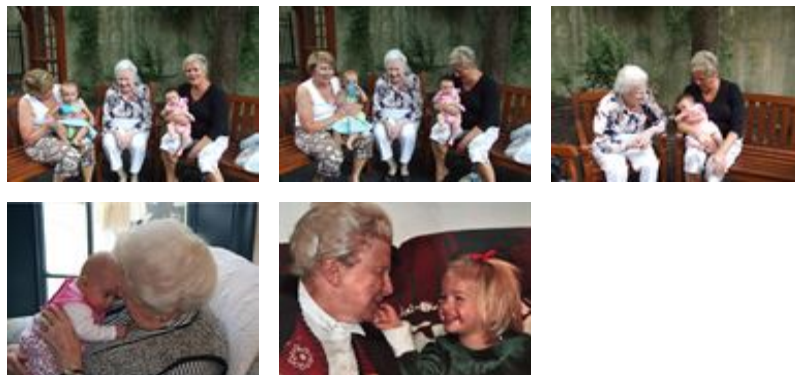

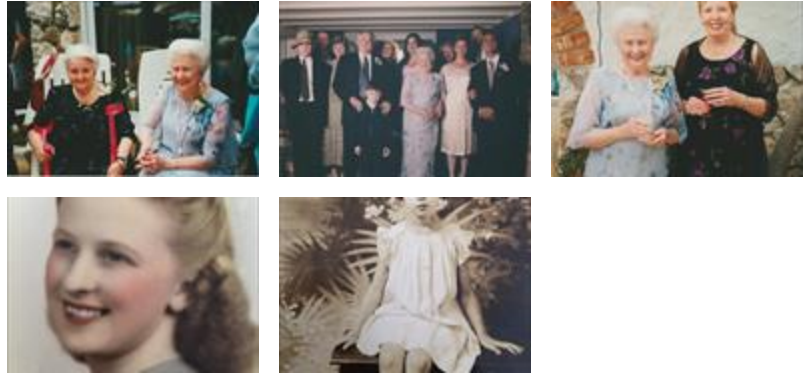
