



Eleanor Brownlee

November 27, 1911 - December 16, 2006

Eleanor J. Brownlee age 95 of Pennsville, passed away Saturday, December 16, 2006 in Merion Gardens, Carneys Point, NJ. Born in Brooklyn, NY on November 27, 1911, she was the Daughter of the late Frederick and Amelia Ann Charleton Brownlee. A Registered Nurse she graduated from St. Thomas Hospital, Nashville, Tennessee in 1936 and returned to Pennsville. On February 16, 1942 she entered the Aerial Nurse Corp (Army Air Corp) and participated in four military campaigns during WWII. She was awarded the Air Medal with oak leaf cluster, Asiatic-Pacific Campaign Medal with four bronze battle stars. Also the WWII Victory medal with three overseas service bars. She was discharged as an 1st Lieutenant on December 28, 1945. Following her WWII military services, she was employed by the Memorial Hospital of Salem County as the Assistant Director of Nurses, retiring in 1971. After her Retirement from nursing she was employed as a Librarian at Salem Community College from 1975-1985. Miss Brownlee is survived by her Nephew, Charles Frederick Sparks; 5 Great Nephews; 3 Great Nieces, and their families.
