February 2, 1818 - October 17, 2009

Emerson W. Vickery, age 91 of Carneys Point passed away peacefully on October 17, 2009. He was born on February 2, 1918 in Penns Grove to Frances and George Vickery. He graduated from Penns Grove Consolidated High School and attended Drexel School of Electrical Engineering.
