July 18, 1926 - August 23, 2008

Frank H. Maurer, Sr. "Pop" 82 of Penn's Grove was reunited with his wife on Saturday, August 23, 2008 at 8:50 PM at Southgate Health Care Center, Carneys Point where he was a resident. Born in Penns Grove, son of the late Arthur L. and Sarah Flath Maurer, he had been a lifelong Penns Grove resident.
