Frank P. Vinciguerra “Mr. V” passed away Wednesday, November 3, 2010.

He was born August 26, 1932 to the late Alfredo and Mary Vinciguerra in Camden, NJ and became a lifelong resident of Penns Grove.

Frank retired from DuPont in 1985 after thirty-five years of service.

He served in the US Navy during the Korean Conflict. While in the Navy he met his wife Charlotte who was also in the Navy. They were married October 1, 1955 in St. James RC Church, Penns Grove, and had five children.

Frank graduated from Penns Grove High School where he played football and baseball.

Coach Vince is survived by his wife of 55 years, Charlotte and five children; Frank “Rocky” of Penns Grove, Vincent (Deanna) of Wilmington, DE, Tina (Joe) of Middletown, DE, Dean of Boca Raton, FL and Dante (Marci) of North Stonington, CT. He also leaves nine grandchildren and his brother, Thomas Vinciguerra of Pennsville.

He was predeceased by his parents, Alfredo and Mary Vinciguerra and his

sister, Rosetta "Dolly" McGrory.

A viewing will be held on Sunday evening from 7 to 9 PM in the Ashcraft Funeral Home, 47 State St., Penns Grove.

Mass of Christian Burial will be celebrated 10 AM Monday in Corpus Christi RC Church, 369 Georgetown Rd., Carneys Point.
