George J. Fletcher, age 60, of Pennsville, NJ passed away peacefully on Wednesday, November 8, 2017. Born in Pennsville, NJ on July 28, 1957, he was the son of George and the late Marlene Fletcher. 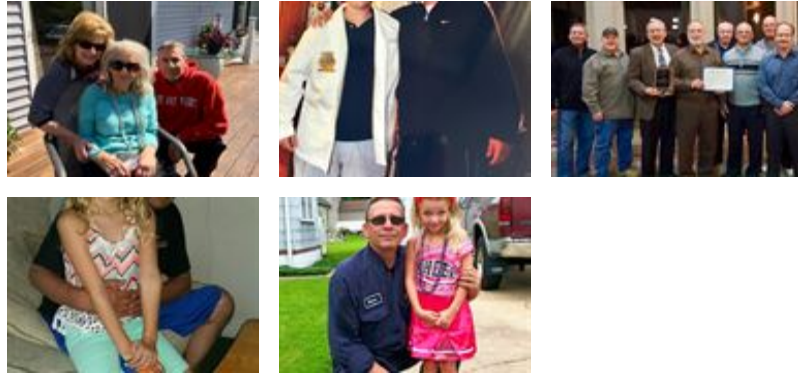
