June 28, 1920 - April 24, 2010

Harry Wetherill Fullerton, MD of Carney's Point and Ocean City, NJ passed away at his home on April 24, 2010. He was 89 years old.

He was born in Philadelphia to Harry and Lillie Fullerton on June 28, 1920.

He was raised in Philadelphia and one of his proudest accomplishments was becoming an Eagle Scout. He graduated from Overbrook High School and went on to Temple University and Jefferson Medical College. He completed his residency at Abington Memorial Hospital. He was a Captain in the US Army and was stationed at Fort Sam Houston, Brooks Army Hospital in San Antonio, TX. He moved to Carney's Point in 1949 to set up a family practice. While practicing medicine he served as Chief of Staff at the Memorial Hospital of Salem County. He was also a member of the Board of Trustees of the Medical Society of New Jersey. In June of 1988 he retired from practicing medicine after 39 years.

He is survived by his wife of 66 years, Martha, his children Joyce Zwickert and husband Bill of Wilmington, DE, Karen Govett and husband Don of Phoenix, AZ, and Wayne Fullerton and wife Paula of Durham, NC. He is also survived by his grandchildren Bevin, Bethany, Shannon, Ryan, Andrew, Katherine and Adam, and great grandchildren Hunter, Riley, Marley, Austin, Lily, Colin and baby Lily Ann.
