Helen I. Malloy (nee Villecco) age 100 of Pennsville passed away on Tuesday July 14, 2105 at home with her family by her side.

Helen was a 30-year resident of Pennsville and a 20-year member of the Women's Club of Pennsville Inc. She was a volunteer for Meals on Wheels of Salem County until the age of 95 years old, she was a Friend of the Pennsville Public Library; a member of the Altar & Rosary Society of Queen of the Apostles Church, and she had volunteered at the Oldmans Township Elementary School in home economics instructing the students in crocheting, knitting, sewing and baking.

She had been a Pennsville resident since 1985, and prior to that, she resided in Camden.
