



## Henry Drimones

July 24, 1925 - March 27, 2007

Henry (Pantelis) Drimones, age 81 of Pennsville passed away on Tuesday, March 27, 2007 at the Memorial Hospital of Salem County. He was born July 24, 1925 in Englewood, NJ to the late Clara (nee Notou) and Nicholas Drimones. Mr. Drimones served in the US Army for 2 years during WWII as a member of the 87th Infantry Golden Acorn Division. He received the American Campaign Medal, WWII Victory Medal, Good Conduct Medal and two Purple Hearts. His tour of duty took him through the European Theatre. In the early 1950's, he and his late brother Peter Drimones went into business together starting with Pete's Farm Market. Later they opened the Olympia Diner and Olympia Dairy Bar. Upon his brother's death in 1983 he continued to own and operate Olympia Dairy Bar along with his niece and nephew. Mr. Drimones was a member of Holy Trinity Greek Orthodox Church in Wilmington, DE. He is survived by one sister, Corrine Bissari of Haddon Heights, Sister-in-law, Carnation Drimones, niece, Clara Drimones and nephew, Nicholas Drimones all of Pennsville. He was predeceased by his brother, Peter Drimones and his sister, Mary Lambi. A viewing will be held on Thursday from 9 to 10 AM in the Ashcraft Funeral Home, 740 S. Broadway, Pennsville. Funeral services will be held 11 AM Thursday in Holy Trinity Greek Orthodox Church, Wilmington, DE. Interment will follow in Lawnside Cemetery, Pilesgrove.
