Henry J. Mauser, Jr. age 82 of Carneys Point died Wednesday, December 19, 2007 at Christiana Hospital. He was born in Hazelton, PA on December 31, 1925. At the age of 17, Henry joined his three brothers in service, entering into the United States Merchant Marines during WWII as an able bodied seaman. All brothers returned home safely. He then started employment at DuPont – Plant 1 where he was a shift supervisor in the production of gun powder and nitrocellulose. His dedication to safety saved many lives. He attended Corpus Christ RC Church and remembered fond moments of poker night with Father Rocco and Dr. Rapone.
