



Jesse Henry Green Jr.

December 28, 1918 - June 16, 2015

Jesse Henry Green, Jr., died June 16, 2015 at Crosslands Community in Kennett Square, PA. He was 95. He is survived by his wife of nearly 69 years, Elizabeth S. Green, and five children: James Green (Pamela) of Newark, DE, Barbara Green (Alan Geyer, predeceased) of Bethesda, MD, Donald Green (Marianne) of Sellersville, PA, Stephen Green (Diana Williams) of Denver, CO, and Katharine Green (Philip Helzer) of Amherst, MA. He had eight grandchildren and six great-grandchildren. He was the only child of the late Jesse H. Green Sr. and Virginia S. Green.

Mr. Green grew up and lived in Carney's Point, NJ until his move to Kennett Square. He was a lifelong member of Union Presbyterian Church in Carneys Point and sang in its choirs for about 75 years. He served in the 515th Ordnance Company in the U.S. Army during World War II, following the front line through western Europe. A graduate of Washington College, Chestertown, MD, he was a chemist for the DuPont Company at its Chambers Works plant. He was active in the DuPont Veterans Association, especially its annual clambake.

After retirement he enjoyed working in a hardware store and served regularly as a poll worker. He volunteered at Longwood Gardens and traveled the country with his wife, often serving on church work teams at volunteer construction projects. He became a skilled silversmith and made elegant

Nantucket baskets, glass beads and annual Christmas fudge.
