



## Jonathan Garbini

September 8, 1962 - April 2, 2013

Jonathan J. Garbini, born September 8, 1962, died peacefully at home on Tuesday, April 2. He was a graduate of Salesianum High School in Wilmington, De, Glassboro College, Glassboro, NJ and Thomas Cooley Law School in Lansing, Michigan earning his Juris Doctorate degree. While attending Cooley Law School, he was the recipient of the honored Blue Book Award for his writings on Constitutional Law. He began his legal career in the Salem County Prosecutors Office as an Assistant Prosecutor. He formed the Law Offices of Jonathan J. Garbini in Pennsville in 1995. He served his community in various capacities; he was the former Solicitor and Labor Relations Coordinator for the Penns Grove-Carneys Point School District for many years. He formerly served as municipal prosecutor in several different municipalities in the Salem County area. He served on the Advisory Board of the YMCA. He also held the position of Adjunct Professor at Salem Community College and is a Paul Harris Fellow.

Predeceased by his mother, Mary V. Garbini and brother, Timothy J. Garbini. He is survived by his wife, Judith, father, Emo J. Garbini, son, Jonathan J. Garbini, Jr., brother, Steven J. Garbini and wife Janice, sister, Lisa G. Moffet and husband, Kevin, Stepsons, Clinton Gerber and wife Nadia, Aaron Gerber and wife, Karen and Stephen Gerber and wife, Kimberly along with four granddaughters.
