Karen Schoenfeld Buncich, age 78, a long-time resident of Pennsville, New Jersey, passed away peacefully on March 14, 2025, in Cape Coral, Florida, with her family by her side. 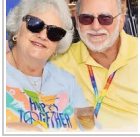
