March 4, 1940 - February 23, 2023

Kathleen E. Chance (nee Charlton) passed away suddenly on February 23rd, 2023 just short of her 83rd birthday on March 4th. Kathleen is bereaved by her son Joseph Conrad, daughter Lisa Conrad Pratta and fiancé Jeffrey Sparks, son Von Chance and fiancé Melinda Lovell, and grandson Ayden Chance. Kathleen was predeceased by her parents Joseph and Sarah Charlton of Carneys Point.

Kathleen worked for many years at Dougherty's Pharmacy, Penn Stereo, Pureland, Carneys Point Township, and in the accounting department for Wire-Pro.

Kathleen was a strong advocate for improving mental health. She was a member of the Mental Health Board of Salem County for many years. Kathleen was presented with the NAMI 1992 Community Education Award for her dedication to educating the community about mental health and mental illness.

Kathleen was also instrumental in initiating CSP (Collaborative Support Program) in Salem County. By originating this, she also created "New Dimensions"; an outlet for the mentally ill to gather in order to facilitate their lives. As a result of opening up CSP to this area, it also expedited more counseling for the mentally ill as well as assistance in finding housing and

shelter for individuals with needs.

Kathleen received awards, accolades, and certificates over the years as an active champion in her service to the mentally ill. We are extremely honored by Kathleen's dedication to an area that is still strongly overlooked in our society.
