



Kenneth Louis Kirsch

August 30, 1960 - December 28, 2025

It is with great sadness that the Kirsch family announces the passing of Kenneth Louis Kirsch.

Kenny passed away on December 28, 2025, at the age of 65. Kenny died doing what he loved, flying.

Born on August 30, 1960, at Wilmington Hospital, he was the son of the late Louis J. Kirsch and Edith D. Kirsch (nee Drudi) of Carney's Point, New Jersey. Kenny graduated from Penns Grove Regional High School Class of 1978 and the New York Institute of Technology, where he obtained a Bachelor of Architecture (B.Arch) degree. Kenny's professional career as a licensed architect spanned several states and architecture firms, most recently with Clemente + Ivins Architects, LLC in West Chester, Pennsylvania. Some of Kenny's designs can be seen in Camden, Gloucester, and Salem Counties, including his family's former bar, "Dinos in the Woods," which operated in the 1990s in Carneys Point.

Kenny's talents were not just in architecture; if something had a motor, he was interested. Kenny loved anything with an engine. Throughout his life, he owned, fixed, broke, rebuilt, and restored cars, boats, motorcycles, airplanes, and helicopters.... flying was his true passion.

Kenny will be remembered for his kindness and generosity to others, always willing to help someone in need or help with a project of any kind. Kenny adored his niece and nephew and beamed with pride whenever he shared stories of their life's adventures.

Kenny was a beloved son, husband, brother, nephew, and uncle...he was the best Grunkle (grumpy uncle) to Kevin and Kira. Kenny loved everyone like they were his own family; he was everyone's "Uncle Kenny".

In addition to his parents, Louis & Edith Kirsch, Kenny was predeceased by his sister-in-law Peggy Kirsch, uncles Edward (Dino) Drudi and Julio Drudi, and former in-laws Russell & Vera Pierson.

Kenny is survived by his brother Michael Kirsch, nephew Kevin Kirsch, niece Kira Kirsch, former wife Martina Pierson, and so many close friends who were like his family and are deeply mourning his loss.
