It is with deepest sorrow that we announce the passing of our beloved daughter, mother, sister, sister in-law, aunt, and friend, Kristen L. Zane. Kristen, a lifelong resident of Pennsville, passed away suddenly at her residence on November 10, 2024, at age 43. Born in Wilmington, Delaware to Sharon (Chambers) Sammons and James Zane Sr.

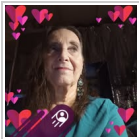
