December 18, 1919 - October 17, 2009

On October 17, 2009, Margaret Ann (Jordan) Campo passed away with her family by her side. She was born on December 18, 1919 in Penns Grove to Peter and Rosa LaMarra Jordan. She graduated from Penns Grove High School in 1938 and worked in the family business of Peter Jordan Fuel during World War II. Margaret was employed as a teacher's aide in the Penns Grove-Carneys Point School district for 19 years. She was a member of St. James Catholic Church, Salem County Memorial Hospital Senior Circle, Republican Club, a volunteer at Salem County Memorial Hospital and Carneys Point Town Watch, former VP of Penns Grove-Carneys Point Women's Club and performed in the Salem Memorial Hospital Follies for nine years.
