Margaret Susan Malone Lake, age 78 of Pennsville, N.J. passed away peacefully at home on Thursday, June 18th, 2020, surrounded by her family.

Sue was also blessed with numerous nephews, nieces, sisters/brothers-in-law, cousins, and friends/coworkers that were like family. Sue was predeceased by her husband Bill in 1985.
