Marietta R. Cooley (Dorn), age 79, Carneys Point, NJ, passed away Tuesday, August 1, 2023, at Christiana Hospital, Newark, DE.

She was born in Koslin, Germany, which is now known as Poland, and raised in Berlin, Germany. Marietta came to the United States at the age of 19, and obtained her American citizenship in the State of Louisiana.

She retired as a Comptroller after a lengthy career working for car dealerships in DE and NJ. Marietta enjoyed going to the beach, traveling, gardening, reading, classical music, crossword puzzles, and giving talks about the history of Berlin, Germany. She was an inactive member of The Union Presbyterian Church, Carneys Point, NJ.

Marietta was preceded in death by her mother, Margarete Dorn (Conradt); her father, Karl K. Dorn; and, sister-in-law, Ingrid Dorn.

She is survived by her daughter, Claudia I. Cooley, of Pennsville, NJ; brother, Rainer Dorn; nephew, Martin Dorn (Andrea); niece, Corinna Harden; two great niece's and one great nephew, all of Berlin, Germany.

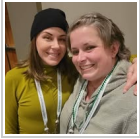
