A music lover throughout her entire life, she enjoyed listening to the oldies and attended Doo-Wop concerts when possible... not to mention she was a huge John Denver and Barry Manilow fan, knowing the lyrics and melodies to every song.

After raising her family, she returned to work later in life where she enjoyed 14 years serving the community as a pharmacy tech and cashier at the Pennsville SuperFresh.

Perhaps most memorable was Mary Jane's quiet faith and strength in the Lord, Jesus Christ. Her firm belief in Jesus brought her family much comfort in her last days. She never feared or doubted what lie ahead of her as she knew she would go to heaven and that she would see everyone in her family again.
