Mary Tighe Sierocinski, 87 of Carneys Point passed away on Wednesday, November 23, 2011 at her home.

Born in Carneys Point on May 6, 1924, daughter of the late Jeremiah and Mary Flynn Scully (both immigrants from Ireland), Mary spent most of her life in the Carneys Point area.

Graduating from St. James High School, Class of 1942, and Goldey Beacom Business School, Mary retired from DuPont – Chambers Works in 1982 with 40 years service. She spent 26 years in D&C Tech Lab with her tenure in the Control Supervisors office – she was promoted and transferred to Jackson Lab Management Division in 1976 where she remained until her voluntary retirement.
