Milton L. Borum, age 86 of Carneys Point died Sunday, December 30, 2007 at Friends Village, Woodstown. Born in Portsmouth, VA, one of six children of the late Walter and Pearl Howard Borum, he had been an area resident since 1945. He served in the US Army during WWII and later in the National Guard. Mr. Borum retired in 1974 following over 25 years of service from DuPont – Plant One, where he had been employed as an explosives operator.
