Naomi K. Trostel, age 92, of Carneys Point, NJ went home to be with the Lord on Tuesday, June 3, 2020.

Naomi was born in Duryea, Pennsylvania. She graduated from Asbury College in Kentucky with a B.S. in Science. She was employed by Pennsylvania Hospital in Philadelphia before moving to Carneys Point in 1955. She was a science teacher at Penns Grove High School from 1972-1992. After her retirement, she continued to be active in the community in the Women's Club, serving as a volunteer at Salem Hospital for over 25 years, and being an active member at First Baptist Church of Pedricktown. She also travelled extensively throughout the United States.

She was preceded in death by her husband David Trostel and son-in-law Neil Taylor, as well as by her parents Frank and Edna Kramer and brother Robert C. Kramer. Naomi is survived by her daughters Barbara Hall (Timothy), Cheryl Stieg (Bernard Woodridge) and Deanne Rinnier (Edward). She is also survived by 8 grandchildren and 9 great-grandchildren: Stephen Stieg (Colleen, Cameron, Connor, Jackson), Daniel Stieg, Erik Hall (Meghan, Henry, Hannah), Andrea Stieg (AJ Santos, Evelyn), David Stieg (Alison, Nolan), Keri McBeth (Charles), Joshua Taylor (Julie, Ethan), Rachael McDowell (Michael, Ella).
