Robert “Bob” C. Brayerton, Sr., age 70 of Carneys Point and beloved husband of Donna, was called from his earthly labor to his home in glory on Wednesday October 25. Bob pastored for the past 34 years in Trainer, Pennsylvania and Carneys Point, NJ. He planted Grace Christian Fellowship of South Jersey in Carneys Point.

A graduate of Penns Grove High School, he also received his Bachelor of Science degree in Pastoral Ministry from United Wesleyan College in Allentown, PA and attended Indiana Wesleyan University (formerly Marion College) in Marion, IN. He had a passion for preaching the Word of God and encouraging others.

Robert previously worked for the E.I. DuPont Company, Chambers Works in Carneys Point, Salem County Hospice in Pennsville, NJ and Fortress Steel in Elkton, MD. He was the Chairman of the Carneys Point Industrial Commission for Economic Development and served on the DuPont Community Advisory Panel as well as participated in the Carney’s Point Police Chaplaincy program and was a past president of the Penns Grove/Carneys Point/Pedricktown Ministerium.
