Robert D. Milhoan age 59 of Quinton Township, passed away Saturday, September 29, 2007 at the Memorial Hospital of Salem County following a long illness. Born in Ravenswood, W.V. son of the late Hod and Vera Cather Milhoan, he had lived in Salem County since 1973. He was one of 11 children.
