



## Skeeter Herrman

Grover S. "Skeeter" Herrman, 86, lifelong resident of Deepwater, NJ passed away peacefully at home on Sunday, April 7, 2013.

Skeeter is survived by his wife of 64 years, Louise; daughters Diane Ford, Pennsville, Linda Murphy (Dennis), Newark, DE; grandsons, Jason Ford, (Ashley) Columbia, SC, and Chris Murphy, Newark, DE; and sister, Pearl Keene, West End, NC. Skeeter served in the U.S. Navy during both WWII and the Korean War. Skeeter retired from the DuPont Company, where he worked for 38 yrs. as a Construction Supervisor. After retiring, he worked for the Township of Pennsville as Zoning Officer for 13 years.

Skeeter was a lifetime member of the Deepwater Fire Department with over 65 years of volunteer service. He held the offices of President, Vice President, Assistant Chief, and served as Chief of the department from 1971-1979.
