Stephen D. Powers of Carneys Point died unexpectedly at home on Friday, August 6, 2010.

Mr. Powers was born on June 3, 1953 in Salem. He grew up in Carneys Point and graduated from Penns Grove High School in 1971. He then studied at Richard Stockton College of New Jersey, graduating in 1975.

After working for several companies in the manufacturing business, Mr. Powers founded Argus Corporation in Newark, DE in the mid – 1980's. Argus manufactured polyurethane foam earplugs for use in the manufacturing environment. He sold the business in 2005.

In addition to his business interests, Mr. Powers enjoyed traveling, making frequent visits to Brazil to visit his extended family. He was also an avid fisherman and home remodeler.

Mr. Powers is survived by his wife Marcia Rodrigues and stepdaughter Saura Rodrigues of Sao Paulo, Brazil; his mother Jean Featherer Powers of Frederick, PA; brother Mike Powers (Jacquie) of Ithaca, NY; sister Carol Weitzenkorn (Gregg) of Pottstown, PA; and several aunts, uncles, nieces, nephews and cousins.
