Ted Wallace passed away on Tuesday December 30, 2025 at 82 years of age. Ted served honorably in the Western Pacific area during the Viet Nam era in the U.S. Navy (1961-1964). During his tour of duty, his ship and squadron with fully equipped U.S. marines were deployed to Cuba for the Cuban blockade. After his military service, he moved to New Jersey and worked at Mobil Research ExxonMobil in Paulsboro, NJ. He retired as a senior lab tech from ExxonMobil after 36 years of service in 2001.
