Victor Ritzendollar, age 85 of Layton's Lake, Carneys Point, NJ died September 10, 2006 at his home. Of Dutch/German descent, Victor's paternal great grandfather, Victor Ritzendollar emigrated from Alsace Lorraine to Chatsworth, NJ in the early 1800s and established a thriving business. Born in Mays Landing, NJ, on June 28, 1921, to Victor, II and Lucinda Steele Ritzendollar, Victor grew up on Lake Lenape. His favorite pastime was exploring the lake and surrounding woods, observing and enjoying the outdoors and hunting with his father. He was a veteran of World War II, having spent four years in the Mediterranean and in North Africa. He retired from DuPont Chambers Works in 1981 after 42 years of service and continued to enjoy the outdoors at Layton's Lake, Carneys Point, where he and Marion, his wife of 63 years, shared their home. He was generous with his talents and skills, often helping others with household emergencies. He is survived by his loving wife, Alice Marion (nee Gamon), a daughter, Lucinda R. Lewis and son-in-law, G. Philip Lewis, Esq., of Woodstown, NJ; two grandchildren, A.
